Diwali Celebration

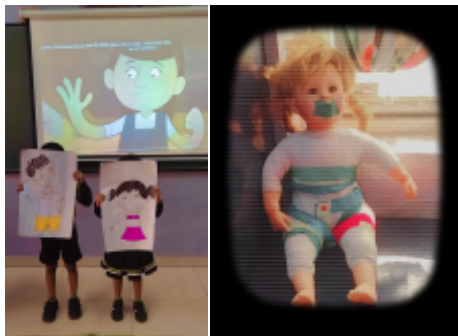

Good Touch , Bad Touch.

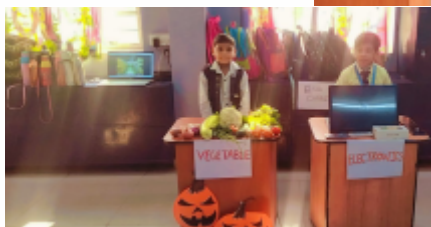

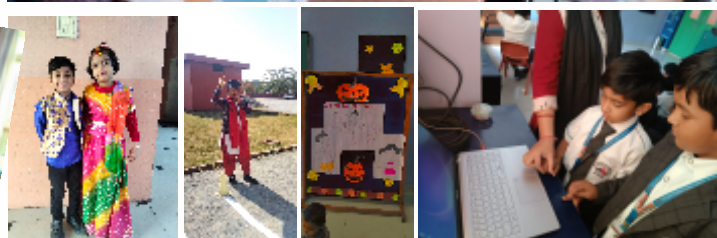
Halloween Day
